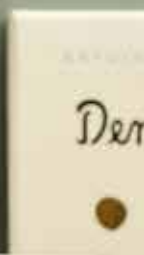

Our philosophy

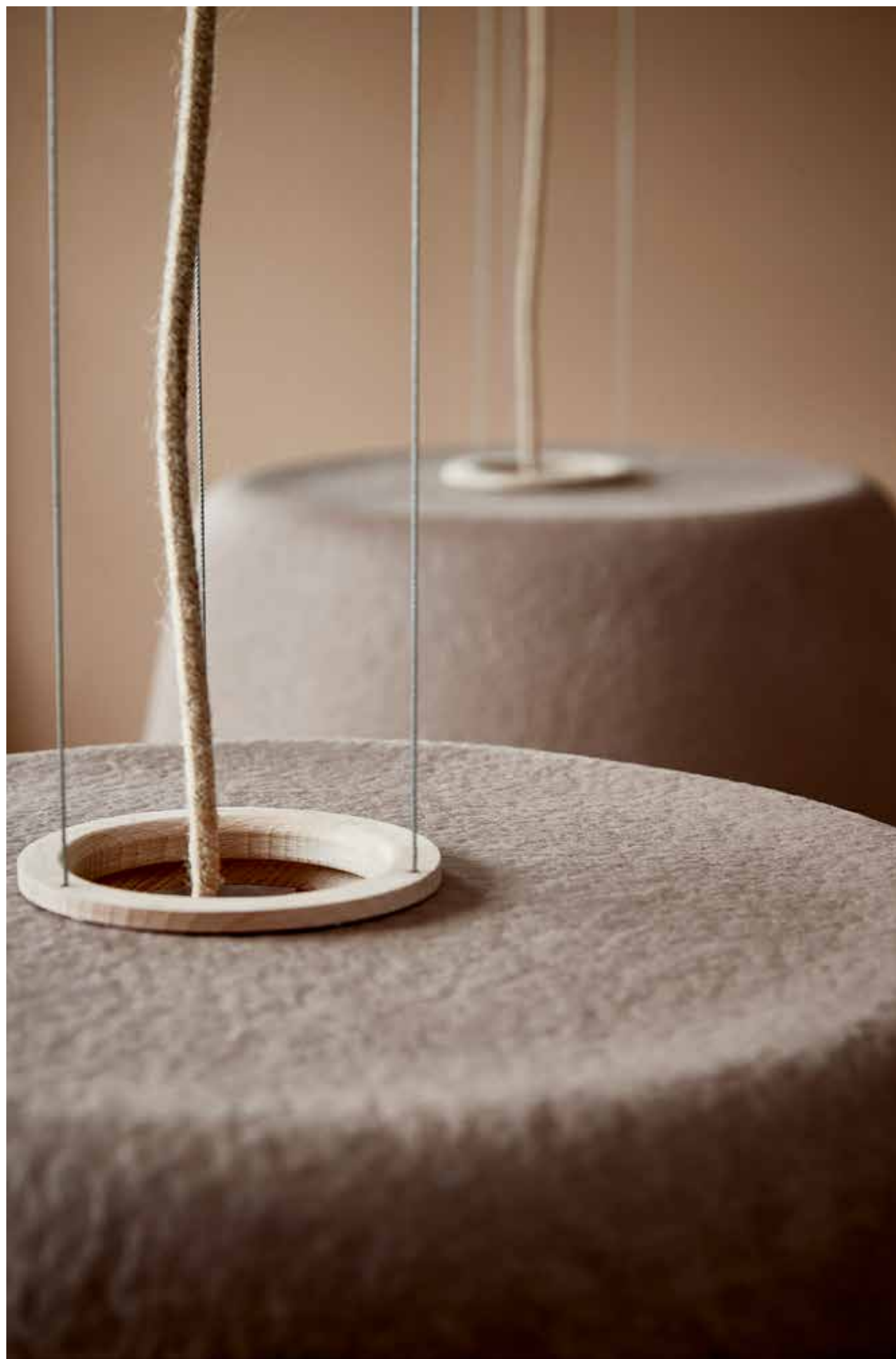

Recycled paper

Our products are made from 100% recycled paper and water without adding any binders. To achieve our delicate hues, a trace amount of dye is mixed into the paper pulp. The final creations are fully biodegradable, allowing for disposal either as organic waste or recyclable material.

The beauty of paper

Paper, a derivative of wood, plays a significant role in the natural carbon cycle by absorbing atmospheric CO₂. By using recycled paper, we contribute to a circular economy, thereby amplifying the positive environmental impact.

Often overlooked, paper is a medium rich in grace, subtlety, and poetic resonance. It has long been an integral pillar of our economies, societies and cultures.

Our paper paste products bear a tactile resemblance to refined leather or natural wood, acquiring a unique patina over time. Each item is hand-moulded and will all have minor imperfections, further reaffirming the object's poetry and sheer natural beauty. One piece will never be exactly like another, giving it a unique expression.

Local manufacturing

Pasqual Arnella is a fourth-generation family-owned business with an enduring history that traces back to 1892. Originating as creators of toys and carnival masks using papier maché, the company has evolved into pioneering an array of innovative paper paste items.

The recycled paper is collected near Barcelona from KM0 recovery facilities. The paper pulp is transformed into distinctively textured pieces using an innovative moulding technique. With over a century-long expertise in cellulose manipulation, Pasqual Arnella's mastery deeply informs and enriches our capabilities, pushing the limits of what is achievable with paper as a medium.

Handle with care

Paper paste is a robust material but should still be treated well. Light moisture won't damage the surface, and if water is spilt on the product, it will dry and keep its shape. Any dust or dirt can be gently brushed off.

DO NOT USE paper paste products in very wet surroundings. They aren't made for the outdoors, so keep them inside and in dry surroundings to ensure they stay looking their best.
